The Cooperation Proclamation was intended to stop escalating e-discovery costs which have threatened to undermine the civil justice system. Since its issuance, nearly 100 state and federal judges have signed on as endorsers of the Proclamation. It has also been cited in at least a dozen reported court decisions, and it has received widespread press coverage.

To celebrate the Proclamation's first anniversary, The Sedona Conference Journal is publishing a special Supplement to Volume 10, devoted to the theme of "cooperation," with a preface by Associate Supreme Court Justice Stephen Breyer.
